Who Should Apply?

Value of the Scholarship:

The Catholic Education Pathways Scholarship offers up to 50% remission of tuition fees for 2027.

Scholarship Focus:

The scholarship recognises students who exhibit:

- Alignment with St Brigid's College values - Hospitality, Service, Respect, Hope, Trust, and Aspiration.
- Active engagement in school and community – such as participation in school activities, sports, parish involvement, service programs, or cultural events.
- Academic effort - with a focus on commitment, growth, and work habits.
- Leadership qualities - examples may include school captain, peer mentor, sports captain, or informal leadership.
