

Sister Brigid Arthur Scholarship for Excellence

Sister Brigid Arthur was the Foundation Principal of our College in 1968. Since that time, Sr Brigid Arthur has worked tirelessly to advocate for the rights of refugees within the High Court of Australia.

St Brigid's College is currently seeking applications for scholarships from suitably credentialed students. These scholarships are open to students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026 and offer up to 50% remission of tuition fees.

The scholarships are awarded to students who display talent in a variety of areas including, but not restricted to;

- leadership,
- commitment to community service.
- sport,
- performing arts, visual arts and
- · academic ability,

and of equal importance, sustained commitment to their studies.

The scholarships are offered to give students opportunity to develop their talents in a quality educational environment, that they may not otherwise access without such support. The scholarship is for a period of up to one year and students can apply in subsequent years.

The attached application form is to be completed by the applicant with advice from parents. <u>The application should include:</u>

- A covering letter (written by the student applying for the scholarship)
- Photo of the applicant to be attached to the letter
- Copies of the applicants most recent academic reports and most recent NAPLAN test results;
- Copies of any other documents you believe will support the application (e.g. certificates, awards, newspaper clippings).
- Evidence of involvement in school and co-curricular activities
- References from teachers, tutors, coaches, etc.

If there is insufficient space to fully outline the application, then additional pages may be added. Original certificates should not be sent – photocopies will be sufficient. The best way to present the application is in an A4 display folder.
